Scene 2	New York, morning two days later
Scene 3	New York, midday the next day
Scene 4	Sydney, morning two days later
Scene 5	New York, afternoon the same day
Scene 6	Sydney, morning the next day
Scene 7	New York, afternoon the same day
Scene 8	London, evening the same day
