

When the killer walks in, Phoebe disappears through the nearest door and finds herself in an identical suite, but in the year 1994. Not surprisingly, the suite's occupant, Reece's second wife, Ruella, is sceptical about her explanation. When she too goes through the door and finds herself in the same suite in 1974 with Reece's first wife, Jessica, she decides to rewrite the future. The Hotel detective, Harold, meanwhile keeps a watchful eye on the proceedings.
